The equipment to be located, subject to agreement, in the Community Centre.
10. Henry Street: To confirm that the Clerk is to pursue with the Cheshire Highways Department possible approaches to reinstating the cobbled area of Henry Street that has been damaged by a contractor.
11. Sustainable Communities Bill: To confirm the Parish Council supports the Bill and its principle of increased local involvement in democratic processes and will ask Stephen O'Brien MP to support the Bill
12. Baptist and Methodist Church: To consider the request for a churchyard maintenance grant.
