CWaC and Tarporley Parish Council are working together to prepare a Masterplan for the former Brook Farm school site it owns at Brook Road and additional land to the east of Brook Road.

Why is the development of these sites being considered?

The former Brook Farm School site is owned by Cheshire West and Chester Council and is currently a vacant asset.

The land to the east is 13 acres, 8 acres of this is identified for affordable housing and as a community asset for a range of leisure uses including but not limited to sports, recreation and open space. The need for these uses has previously been identified in the Parish Plan 2008.

A new Neighbourhood Plan is currently being taken forward and there is an opportunity for new leisure and sports facilities to be owned and run by some form of Local Development Trust which would need to raise the necessary capital funding to deliver the facilities.




Masterplan Design Context






Pedestrian connections



Cycling connections








Masterplan Option 1








Masterplan Option 2



Who would develop the site?

The market housing will be developed by a private house builder and the affordable housing will be managed by a housing association. Any sporting or recreational facilities would be developed and managed by the local community, through Tarporley Parish Council or a Local Development Trust, for the benefit of the local community.

What happens next?

Your views will be taken into account and it is anticipated that the masterplan will be completed by the end of April 2012. This will be followed potentially by a planning application, through which there will be a further opportunity for local people to review and comment on proposals for the sites.
