Welcome...

Welcome to this very special issue of Tarporley News, which is given over entirely to Tarporley Parish Council. Brook Road Recreation Field

Why is it Taking so Long? A huge amount of work has been going on behind the scenes in the past three years to push forward the outdoor sports and recreation facility off Brook Road and work on the ground should begin next year

THE FACTS...

- This is the largest single investment and most complex project ever undertaken by Tarporley Parish Council
- Although the site has been discussed since 2013, the Parish Council only took ownership at the end of 2015
- A lengthy village consultation took place in 2015
- The Local Planning Authority always wants to see a lot of information prior to any formal planning application
- Plans need to be up to Sport England and Football Association standards
- The Brook Road planning application was submitted in October 2016, but wasn't granted until February 2018
- Approval is still pending on several regulatory matters prior to any building work commencing
- The Parish Council is working through all regulatory issues, including utilities companies and pitch drainage permissions
- Detailed ecological reports (on newts, bats and badgers) had to be carried out
- It is hoped work will start on the land next year - but a colony of Great Crested Newts needs careful protection
- Money gained from the Taylor Wimpey Development off Brook Road (known as the Section 106 agreement) has been ring-fenced for this facility
- Current funds are not enough to build all facilities straight away, so works will need to be phased with more funding sought
- Tarporley Parish Council says: "We want to get this facility up and running as fast as possible, but hope you understand there are an awful lot of hoops we have to jump through in order to make this happen. We can categorically state - we WILL have an outdoor sports and recreation facility off Brook Road!"

Christmas Lights Switch On Event

Tarporley Parish Council has made a lot of changes to this year's Christmas lights switch-on...

This year's Christmas lights switch on event will take place on Saturday 1st December, in a more central location on the High Street, close to The Old Fire Station Chocolate Shop. To make the event safer, road will be closed (between both Park Road entrances) and the way the village will be lit up this year will also change. Along with the usual stalls - roast chestnuts, mulled wine, choirs, carol singing and, of course, Santa - there will be some added attractions this year, including live reindeer with elf handlers. Dayinsure, a short-term insurance company based in Tarporley, have offered to design and supply a new Santa Grotto. Organised by Tarporley Parish Council, many individuals and businesses get involved to make this one of the most popular annual community events in the village. The event is free to attend.

The Tarporley Christmas Lights switch on takes place in Tarporley on Saturday 1st December, opposite the Old Fire Station Chocolate Shop, from 6pm - 7.30pm. Please arrive between 5.45 and 6pm

Oathills Lea...

Be on the look-out for a 'Housing Needs Survey', which will soon be posted through letter boxes. It's all part of the work by Weaver Vale Housing Trust, Cheshire West and Chester Council, Cllr Eveleigh Moore Dutton and Tarporley Parish Council to identify what kind of accommodation is needed by the over 55s in the village. All of this has come about after Weaver Vale Housing Trust announced the Oathills Lea retirement flats were being put under review. The Parish Council will not be a part of the decision making process. Weaver Vale Housing Trust is expected to make its decision in the early part of next year.
